## **Note to tutors and centres: 2004 onwards**

A number of ESOL qualifications were accredited by the QCA in 2002. Since then, the adult ESOL core Curriculum has become widely available and used in language teaching across the UK. The ESB EAL examinations (as outlined in this handbook) are currently broadly aligned to the Basic Skills standards of the National Qualifications Framework.

Work is now underway to further map the qualifications to the Adult ESOL Core Curriculum. The new qualifications should be available from September 2004. We will, of course, continue to offer qualifications which enable the student, to develop confidence as well as competence.
